LAUNCHING/SLIPS/PARKING (In alphabetic order):

Cabrillo Coastal Park in San Pedro (Launch Ramp) **310-548-2645**
Life Guard Station **310-548-2909**

- attendant on duty 5:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
- cost is \$15 a day to park trailers
- gate closes at 10:00 p.m.
 - Free on winter weekdays until June 1
 - For anchoring out call Harbor Police for safety inspection **310-732-3500**

Channel Islands Harbor Police **805-382-3011**

- 405 N. to 101 N. to Victoria Ave. exit; go 5-7 mi.; office is just before Coast Guard
- from launch, drive to Pelican Wy & go rt. into cul de sac
 - open 24 hours, seven days a week or hail on Ch. 12 if not in office
- have approx. 25 transient slips and can double up boats if necessary
 - take registration papers to office to register
- approx. 25 transient slips are available first come, first served
 - 2002 summer rate .50 ft./winter rate .40 ft.
- free parking (3001 S. Victoria Ave.) if slipping boat
- guest slips also available at
 - Channel Islands Marina
 - Anacapa Isle Marina
 - Peninsula Yacht Anchorage
- anchoring in the harbor is forbidden

- ordinarily parking anywhere under the jurisdiction of Chula Vista or National City could result in a citation but if we call to advise when trailers will be left in J St. parking lot overnight they'll make sure we're not cited
- overnight parking at the Coronado launch ramp is not permitted

Dana Point

- requires "Marine Event Application" from the Orange County Sheriff's Department/Harbor Patrol (949-248-2224), attn: Harbor Master at 1901 Bayside Dr, Corona Del Mar, CA 92625 which they will fax for completion
 - enables the raft-up without individuals having to sign in with Harbor Master
 - contact early for summer stay as they fill up early
 - they need to have possession of application at least one month in advance but that's probably not enough notice
- neither the Harbor Police or Dana Point Marina Co. (949-496-6137) have enough slips to accommodate us
- Dana West Marina (949-493-6222) has no guest slips

- **A-1 La Playa**
 - 25 mooring permits issued per weekend on first come, first served basis
 - can get 90 days in advance
 - good for Friday 9am through Monday 9am
 - need anchor ball, anchor light and porta-potty or holding tank
 - fax boat owners name(s), CF or Document number and phone number to the Mooring Office at 619-686-6566, attn: mooring permits
 - provide Cruise Captain's phone number as contact person
 - after permit numbers are issued contact each boat owner as they'll need their number if Harbor Police check boats
- **A-9 Cruiser Anchorage**
 - need permit and mooring is only for out of county residents
- **A-5 Glorietta Bay**
 - 20 permits issued per weekend on first come, first served basis
 - can get 90 days in advance
 - good for Friday 9am through Monday 9am
 - need anchor ball, anchor light and porta-potty or holding tank
 - fax boat owners name(s), CF or Document number and phone number to the Mooring Office at 619-686-6566, attn: mooring permits
 - provide Cruise Captain's phone number as contact person
 - after permit numbers are issued contact each boat owner as they'll need their number if Harbor Police check boats
- **A-8 Long Term Anchorage**
 - permit needed but no limit on length of stay
 - do not need anchor ball or anchor light
- **A-2 Commercial Basin/America's Cup Harbor**
 - no permit needed
- **A-3 Laurel Street Anchorage**
 - no permit needed
- **A-4 Coronado Anchorage**
 - no permit needed

S.D. Harbor Police slips are available at \$10 per day for the first 5 days and \$20 for the next 5 days. Can only stay 10 days in a 45-day period. Vessel must be at the dock to rent the slip.

San Diego Harbor Patrol manages Mission Bay 619-531-2000
• Mariner's Basin

- no permit needed
- can stay 72 hours

San Diego Harbor Police (and SD Bay Control Office – Enforcement) 619-686-6272
• can overnight park trailer anywhere for 72 hours Fax 619-686-6566
• illegal to sleep in boat in any public place Mooring Office 619-686-6227

San Diego City Parks and Recreation **858-581-7602**

- usually charge \$35 permit fee to have an event in launch ramp parking lot
- require \$1,000,000 liability insurance
- can't have any petroleum based products near water
- can't block traffic
- can probably get around permit fee and liability insurance by writing letter to Henry Mendibles

Oceanside Harbor Police **760-435-4000**

- Maco Shark Tournament has always been the weekend after the 4th of July
- Can apply by mail or in person – Form available on VYC web site
- payment must be made in advance; accept cash or check but no credit cards
- \$0.80 per foot per day (No refunds)

Ventura Harbor Patrol **805-642-8618**

- pay and display machine for parking
 - \$3 per day
- no guest slips but can slip in private marinas
