

SAN DIEGO ANCHORING INFO

Anchoring permits are available at Harbor Police, 1401 Shelter Island Drive from 0800 to 1600 either in person or telephone 619 686-6227. Anchorage is free except at the Transient Dock.

A-1 – (La Playa) – 72 hour “weekend only” anchorage avail from 0900 on Friday through 0900 on Monday. 96 hour anchorage permitted if holidays falls on a weekend. Maximum of 25 boats. Request for anchoring permits may be made up to 30 days in advance. Permits available in person or by telephone 619 686-6227. Individual or raft up anchoring.

A5 – (Glorietta Bay) – Maximum 72 hour anchorage within 7 day period. Permits available in person at Harbor police or telephone 619 686-6227, Individual or raft up anchoring by permit only.

A8 – (South Bay Anchorage near National City) – No time restrictions. Contact Harbor Police for regulatory information.

A9 – (Cruiser Anchorage) – Located between east end of Harbor Island and the US Coast Guard Air Station). Available for non residents of San Diego County only. Permits and information available from Harbor Island Police in person only.

Transient Dock – Slips available at Harbor Police facility at 1401 Shelter Island Drive for up to 10 days in any 40 day period. Fees are \$10 daily for first 5 days and \$20 daily for next 5 days.

Special Events Permit – Of value to VYC because we can use the Special Events Permit for our raft ups. Anchorage is southeast of buoys 6 and 8 around the corner from Glorietta Bay next to the golf course. To get a Special Events Permit, contact Lt Ken Franke 619 725-6077 or 619 972-1463 (cell) at 1401 Shelter Island with a list of the boats and dates of use desired. Special Events Permit will be issued to the responsible party representing VYC. Lt Franke’s office will advise duty Harbor Police Officers of our Special Events Permit.
